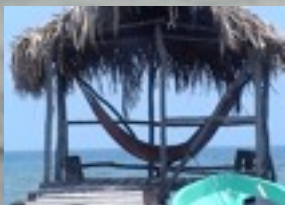
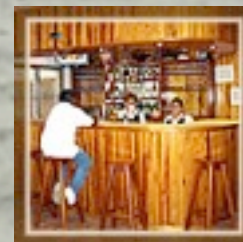


# ISLAND IN BELIZE

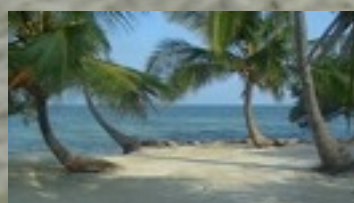
